The workshop will make clear how the strategies can be used to support clear, rigorous academic thinking and expression and how they will serve your content-specific goals.

We pay special attention to developing participants' confidence and skill in teaching note-taking; and in applying skills from earlier workshops to teaching the full essay.

This workshop is designed for teachers of English learners in grades 3-12, including bilingual and co-teaching pairs. The note-taking in this workshop is highly relevant for all content areas. The essay skills however are most relevant to those who teach essay-level writing.
